


From the Pastor's Desk

In the garden of Gethsemane, Jesus urges His disciples to stay awake and that is what should happen with us as we mediate on Jesus' passion – it should awaken us.

If we have been spiritually asleep through a lack of prayer, a lack of church attendance, or living a disoriented life, then we are called to awaken ourselves during Holy Week and reconfirm our desire to being committed to our covenantal responsibilities.

Paul tells us that our attitude must be the same as Christ. While our actions are important, our attitude must be in conformity with Jesus because it is our attitude that shapes our lives, our behavior, and our outlook on the world. The Philippians hymn sings about Jesus' attitude towards life and if we are to be successful in taking up our cross then we must have the same attitude towards life that Jesus has.

The hymn says that Jesus "emptied himself;" Jesus emptied Himself of His divine glory when He became incarnate to bring fullness into our lives. Jesus' attitude toward life was always one of self-giving love. Jesus was so completely dedicated to self-giving love that He went all the way to the cross to fill the emptiness in our lives that had been created by sin.
